Collaborative leadership is the art of leading people as they work together to successfully accomplish both individual and collective goals. To do this, the collaborative leader needs to facilitate many interactions between team members. This two-day workshop is designed to provide collaborative leaders with important facilitative skills that can enhance collaboration and results in the development of high quality, innovative decisions that promote both cohesion and synergy. With collaboration, the group has the potential to fully utilize all the resources team members bring to the table by getting them appropriately focused and prepared to perform so they can be accountable to themselves and the team.

Donna Ching, Ph.D., has been an extension specialist in the College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources at the University of Hawaii-Manoa since 1987. During that time, she has coordinated the Agricultural Leadership Program while working with a variety of nonprofit, for-profit, and community organizations to provide workshops in the areas of group process, leadership, facilitation and strategic planning. She has also facilitated many of these organizations in strategic planning and collaborative decision-making.
